Chap. 483. An Act authorizing the furnishing and equipping of an administration building at the barnstable county fire fighters training school.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 43 of the acts of 1969 is hereby amended by striking out section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

Section 1. The county commissioners of Barnstable county are hereby authorized to construct, equip and furnish an administration building at the Barnstable county fire fighters training school.

Chap. 484. An Act further regulating the operation of Bicycles.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 11B of chapter 85 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the next to the last sentence, as appearing in section 4 of chapter 518 of the acts of 1961, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — This section shall apply only to a bicycle at least one wheel of which is or exceeds sixteen inches in diameter.

Chap. 485. An Act further regulating notice of decisions, orders or rulings of the department of public utilities and appeals therefrom.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The second paragraph of section 5 of chapter 25 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 575 of the acts of 1953, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following two sentences: — Such petition for appeal shall be filed with the secretary of the commission within twenty days after the date of service of the decision, order or ruling of the commission, or within such further time as the commission may allow upon request filed prior to the expiration of the twenty days after the date of service of said decision, order or ruling. The commission shall serve such decision, order or ruling upon all parties in interest by mailing, postpaid, within one day of its being entered, and service shall be presumed to have occurred in the normal course of delivery of such mail.

Chap. 486. An Act authorizing the licensing of a game commonly called beano.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 271 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 6B, inserted by chapter 243 of the acts of 1953, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

Section 6B. Whoever, except as provided in section twenty-two B, sets up or promotes the game commonly known as skilo or any similar
