tax-free, provided that he complies with such rules and regulations as the state tax commission may prescribe, including, but not limited to, rules and regulations to insure that such fuel is used for aviation purposes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on September first, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine. Approved August 31, 1959.

Chap. 541. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO MAKE REGULATIONS TO EXCLUDE, GOVERN AND RESTRICT THE USE OF LIMITED ACCESS AND EXPRESS STATE HIGHWAYS.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would defeat its purpose, which is to immediately provide for the public safety on limited access and express highways, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and convenience.

Be it enacted, ctc., as follows:

Chapter 85 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 2A the following section :—Section 2B. The department for purpose of promoting public safety upon limited access and express state highways, may from time to time make, alter, rescind or add to regulations to exclude, govern and restrict the use of such state highways by horse-drawn vehicles, bicycles, pedestrians, and vehicles determined by the department, because of their type or because of materials or products being transported, as unsafe for limited access and express state highways, bridges, tunnels or overhead highway structures, which regulations may provide penalties for the violation thereof not exceeding twenty dollars for each offense, excepting regulations prohibiting the transportation of unsafe materials or products, the penalties for violation of which shall not exceed five hundred dollars for each offense. Approved August 31, 1959.

Chap. 542. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CLERK **OF** COMMITTEES IN THE CITY OF FALL RIVER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 187 of the acts of 1938 is hereby amended by striking out section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following section:—Section 1. The elerk of committees in the city of Fall River shall be appointed by the city council, to hold office for two years and until his successor is qualified, notwithstanding any provision of chapter forty-three of the General Laws to the contrary.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance during the current year by vote of the eity council of said eity, subject to the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise, and shall apply to appointments beginning with the first Monday of January in the year nineteen hundred and sixty. *Approved August 31, 1959.*
